



RVI's New One Look Interface Options

A simple new "One Look" option that will que up your documents into one PDF window with you passing in the system code and any indexes you would like and a user go just pop you a window of the documents would look like this. Using the new **RVVIEWALL** program.

This retrieves 2 documents and ques them into a PDF and blows them into your browser.

If you have a mix of document types in your selection search you can use the new **RVVIEWALL**

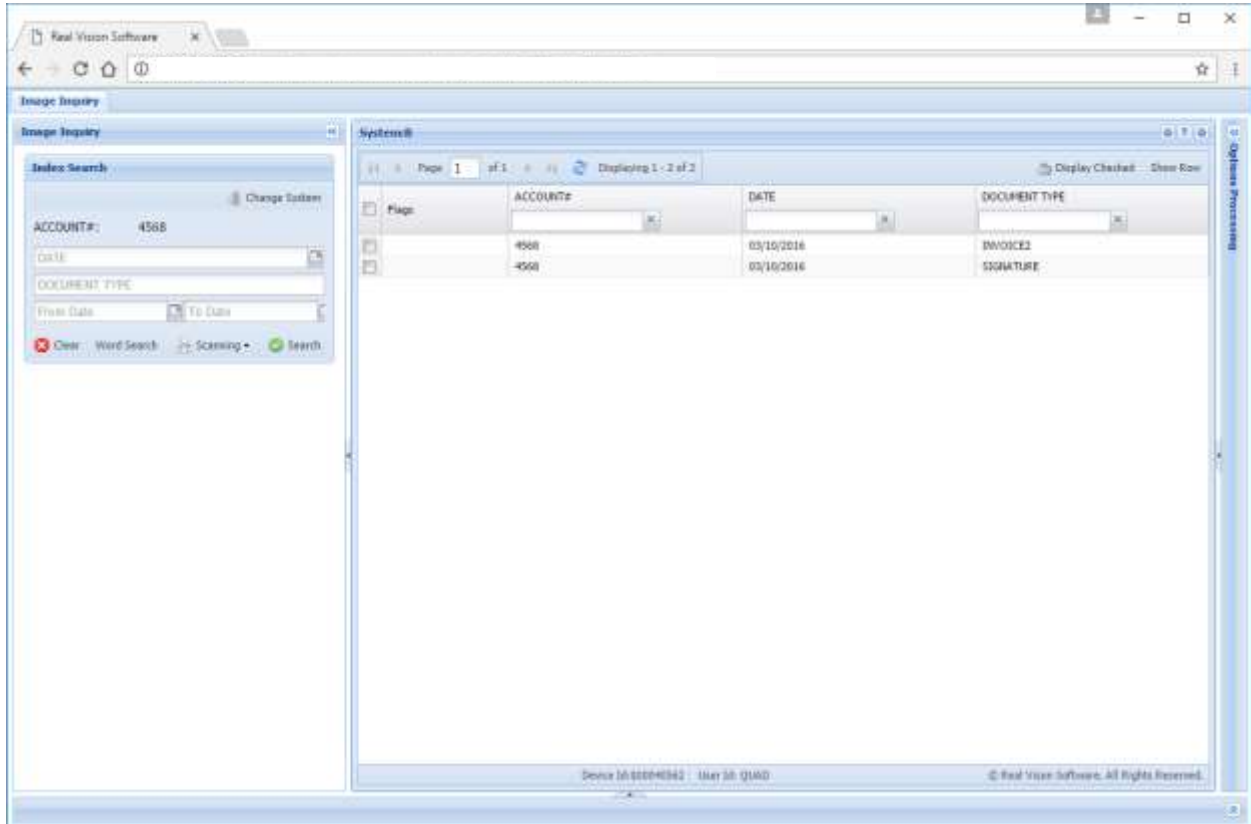
It will put them into a frame and it internally calls a program called **SENCBALL** which gives you a toolbar to flip thru all the documents even if they are PDF, XLS, DOC, etc..



This program quees the documents into a panel so you can flip thru them, since we cannot add OEM documents to one PDF document like in the example before.

If you would like RVI to put up the documents in a One Look window for the user to select and work with the documents we can pass in the ONELOOK=Y parameter.
